In the year one thousand eight hundred & forty six.

An Ordinance establishing the Salaries  
of Secondary City Officers -

Be it ordained by the City  
Council of the City of Cambridge as follows.

The Officers of the City herein after  
named, shall receive the following annual  
Salaries, to be paid in equal quarterly pay-  
ments, which shall be in full for all  
services rendered in their Official Capacity.

City Treasurer - ~~two hundred~~ <sup>one hundred & fifty</sup> Dollars. -

City Clerk, exclusive of Fees } ~~two hundred~~  
established by Law } ~~and seventy~~  
~~three hundred and twenty five~~ <sup>five</sup> Dollars.

Clerk of the Common Council, - one hun-  
dred Dollars. -

Board of Assessors, - five hundred Dollars.

Chief Engineer, - one hundred Dollars. -

Four Assistant Engineers, ~~one hundred~~ <sup>Twenty five</sup> Dollars each.
