Councillors Reeves & Sullivan:

In response to Council Order No. 26, dated 7/31/00, which requested a traffic calming study on Inman Street, Traffic, Parking & Transportation Director Susan Clippinger reports the following:

The Traffic, Parking & Transportation Department conducted a 4 hour vehicle speed study on Inman Street between the hours of 7 a.m. - 8 a.m., 10 a.m. - 11 a.m., 2 p.m. - 3 p.m., and 5 p.m. - 6 p.m. It was determined that out of 643 vehicles, only 4% traveled over the 30 mph limit. Inman Street is 26 feet wide with parking on both sides. With this narrow width and vehicles parked on both sides, a pedestrian can get a false impression that vehicles are speeding. The Department does not feel traffic calming measures are warranted on Inman Street at this time.
