WHEREAS: Residents of the neighborhood surrounding the Tobin School were distressed to see that one of the local favorites, "Lost Zebra", an art work which was placed in the Tot Lot, has been removed for repair after having been severely vandalized; and

WHEREAS: This "Lost Zebra" was much loved by the toddlers in the neighborhood as well as their parents; and

WHEREAS: Some serious thought and consideration should be given as to whether the present site is a place where the "Lost Zebra" can be placed safely; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Arts Council work closely with the Tobin Neighborhood Community School Council to determine where the "Lost Zebra" should be located, and what precautions should be taken to safeguard the sculpture so that the children of the Tobin community will continue to enjoy their friend for many years to come; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Arts Council report back to this City Council on the progress of the repairs and location as soon as possible.
