To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$17,069.28 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salaries & Wages Account (\$16,239.28), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$755.00) and Travel and Training Account (\$75.00) from the Department of Public Health, Massachusetts Tobacco Control Program. The Massachusetts Department of Public Health is granting a 3 month extension to the Department of Human Services existing Tobacco Education Program (Adult At-Risk Populations). The purpose of the funds is to provide tobacco education services to at-risk populations including women, people of color, and linguistic minorities. Funds will be used for salaries and benefits, general operations expenses and required travel expenses.
