ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested on an experimental basis to find a way to empower traffic control officers to enforce the snow and ice removal ordinance (section 12.16.160 B of the Cambridge Municipal Code) or, barring the legality of that, assure that Public Works Enforcement Officers actually implement the law as it stands; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to assure that senior citizens or other persons who cannot clear their sidewalks have a way of getting assistance; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to the City Council on what remedies have been taken to the present unacceptable situation of icy and snowy sidewalks.
