- WHEREAS: James attended local schools and later worked at the Central Scientific Company formerly located in Kendall Square; and
- WHEREAS: James entered the service of the Auxiliary Police on January 14, 1941 and on May 10, 1952 he was promoted to the rank of Sergeant and was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant on April 6, 1956, the position from which he retired on September 1, 1981, completing over forty years of dedicated service to the people of Cambridge; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to John Kilban at the loss of his father and to the entire Kilban family; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to John on behalf of the entire City Council.
