WHEREAS: It has been brought to my attention that when bills are computed and mailed out by the Cambridge Water Department, interest on the amount due begins from the date of billing and not from the date designated as that on which the amount is due. Such a policy flies in the face of fairness. What business charges interest or a late fee if your payment is made within the prescribed period of time ? Now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager request the Superintendent of the Water Department to respond to this inquiry regarding the referenced method of billing, indicating how long it has been departmental policy, what the rationale is behind it, what steps will be taken and how soon to reverse that policy so that henceforth customers will pay late charges only when they are making payments which are indeed late; and be it further
