MAYOR WOLF

- WHEREAS: Section 40 of Chapter 653 of the Acts of 1989 is enabling legislation that allows cities and towns to assess for tax purposes new construction at the time that it is completed; and
- WHEREAS: This would increase our property tax levy from new construction perhaps as much as two to three million dollars in the next year; and
- WHEREAS: To be effective for Fiscal Year 1991, the act would have to be accepted prior to July 1, 1990; therefore, be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager is hereby requested to make a recommendation as soon as possible to the City Council regarding the acceptance of Section 40, Chapter 653 of the Acts of 1989 which would allow Cambridge to assess new construction in a timely manner; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager's recommendation contain the cost of administering this program and the potential benefit of the acceptance of this law.
