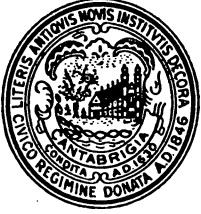

Dear Mr. Sullivan:

I am enclosing a copy of an agreement made with the State Department of Public Works concerning the purchase of a multiple striping machine. At the time of the agreement, it was decided that the painting machine would be purchased with money from the Parking Fund and reimbursed by the State at which time the money would be put back into the Parking Fund.

The State at that time requested an estimated cost of the machine and upon our request encumbered the amount of \$28,750.00 for the fiscal year of 1973 to 1974. If this money is not spent then we will have to resubmit our application and there is a good chance that we will not receive any money for a striping machine.

The striping machine is something Cambridge has needed for quite sometime and it is my opinion that this machine should be purchased immediately.

The difference in our estimate which the State will reimburse and the actual bid price was due to the time difference between the estimate and the bid.

I, therefore respectfully request that the sum of \$32,621.00 be transferred from the Parking Fund to pay for the striping machine and as soon as the State reimburses the City the amount be replaced back into the Parking Fund.

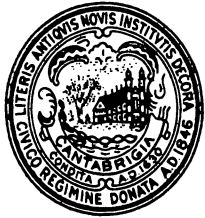


