I walked the length of Speridakis Terrace on November 17, 1977. There no abandoned cars on the street or in any yard on Speridakis Terrace.

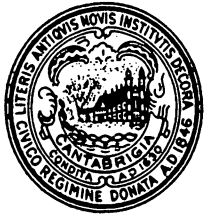

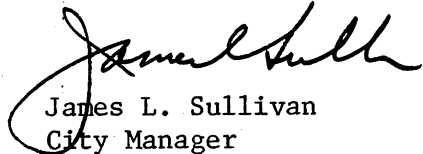
