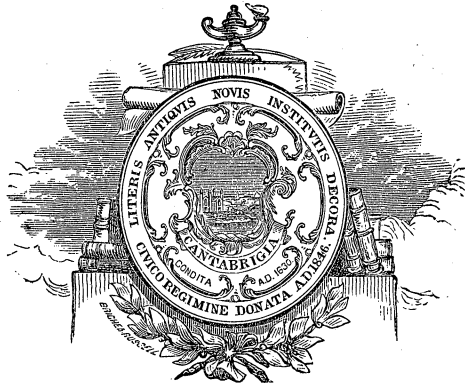

In Board of Mayor and Aldermen, Oct. 7, 1865.

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board, the safety and convenience of the inhabitants require that *Frank Street*, so called, between *State Street* and a *fair road Village* should be *accepted and laid out as a public highway* it is therefore hereby Ordered, that due notice be given to *the owners on said Frank Street*, and *all other persons interested*

that this Board intends to *lay out* the Street before mentioned, by taking a portion of *their* land and laying out the same as a public street—and that *Wednesday*, the *twenty-fifth* day of *October* current, at *six* o'clock, *P. M.*, is assigned as the time for hearing any objections which may be made thereto.

In Board of Aldermen, Oct 7th 1865

The committee on Roads and Bridges to whom was referred the petition of John M St-clair and others that the portion of Front Street between Village and State Street be accepted and graded as a public highway, would respectfully report. That in the opinion of the committee said street should be laid out as a public highway from its junction with State Street to a point extending eightyfive ^{feet} westerly of the west line of Village Street.
