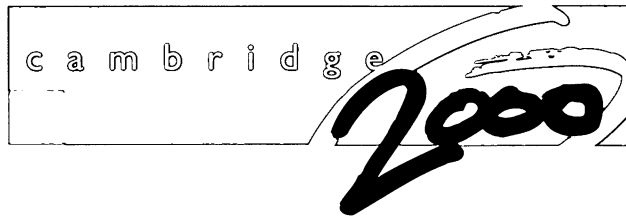

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting a transfer of \$2,950 in the General Fund from the Reserve Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to the Women's Commission Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$2,200) and Travel and Training Account (\$750). The funds in the Ordinary Maintenance Account will be used to support the annual fifth Grade Girls Sports Day. On this day all fifth grade girls throughout the city are bused to the MIT playing field to participate in ten different sports and recreational clinics designed to inspire interest in healthy physical activity.
