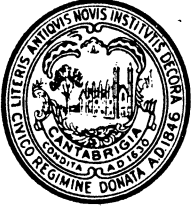

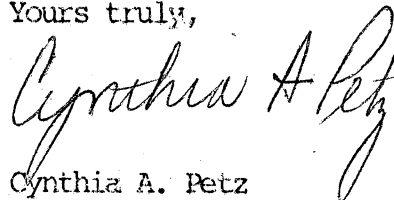

That this license is granted subject to the condition that deWit Transport file with the City Clerk a schedule each year of all passenger rates, routes and any amendments thereto in the future; and be it further

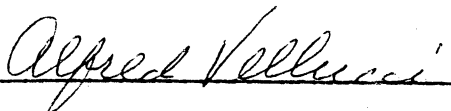

This office represents Mrs. Antje deWit MacMillan who operates deWit Transport, 39 Clinton Street, Cambridge, Massachusetts.

deWit Transport primarily operates vans and mini-buses transporting children to and from various local schools (private and religious), recreational activities and nursery schools.

deWit Transport is now required to obtain a license from the Massachusetts Department of Public Utilities for such activity, which requires that deWit obtain approval from local communities which it services to operate over designated routes.

The route for your community involves the public ways set forth in the attached list. We would appreciate having this matter brought before the appropriate authority for approval of a license to operate on the streets described.

For your convenience we have enclosed a letter acknowledging the granting of said license. (Of course if you prefer to use a different format, please do so.) The approval should be returned to this office in the enclosed addressed envelope.

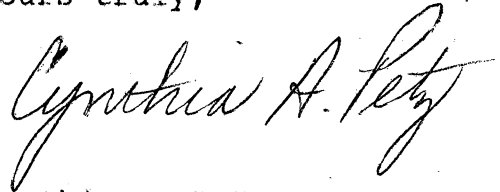
For your information, we also enclose a partial listing of the organizations serviced by deWit.

We understand that many communities are unfamiliar with this type of license as were we. It appears that such local approval (required by the current DPU Regulations) is a somewhat pro forma requirement for obtaining a DPU license at which time a formal hearing is to be held at the DPU.
