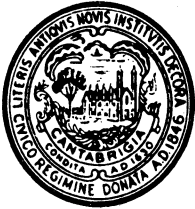

To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 25, regarding parking meters on Bishop Allen Drive, please be advised of the following:

I order to ease the parking for resident of Bishop Allen Drive, the Traffic & Parking Department has reduced the effective time of the parking meters along this street from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday only. This became effective on November 5, 1992 and will allow residents another hour of parking in the morning and afternoon without adding money to the meters. At the present time, we cannot exempt anyone from limited time parking at parking meters or install resident parking only in a non-residentially zoned area.

The order has been referred to the Planning Board for their consideration on a possible zoning change on this street. It has been placed on the Board's agenda for November 10, 1992 and a report of the Board's recommendations should be available to transmit to the City Council in early December.
