IN CITY COUNCIL

August 4, 1980

ORDERED:

That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to the United Pentecostal Church for the erection of a banner across Massachusetts Avenue, from Purity Supreme to Fanny Farmers in Central Square on August 1 through August 16th, 1980.

Provided that before erecting the above named banner, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said banner.
