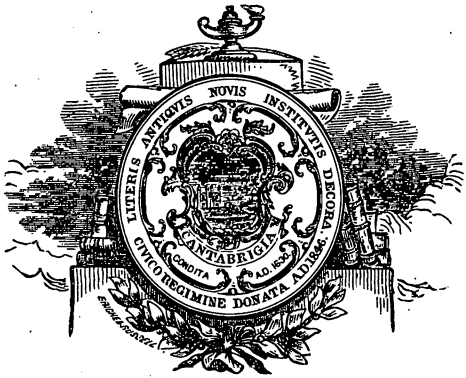




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

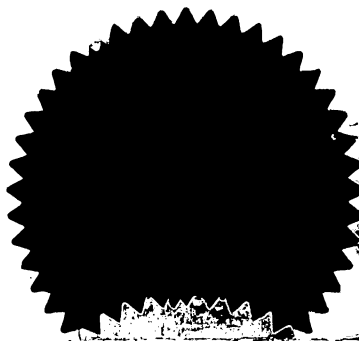
