## IN CITY COUNCIL

### WHEREAS:-

A citizens' Kendall Square Task Force, appointed in July, 1973, as the result of City Council deliberations and actions, recently submitted a number of alternative schemes for development of the 24 acres in the Kendall Square project;

### WHEREAS:-

The Kendall Square Task Force, in terms of the number of meetings it has held, the thoroughness of debate, the diversity of opinions which have been discussed, and the energy and earnestness of its members, has been an enormously important group in attempting, in accordance with City Council guidelines, to decide upon the most acceptable community use of land in the Kendall Square project area;

### AND WHEREAS:-

After the City Council listened in special meeting to a presentation of these alternative schemes last Wednesday night, May 8, 1974, it was requested that the City Manager recommend to the City Council a course of action to be taken for development;

### THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:-

That this City Council, in accepting the alternatives presented by the Task Force and its technical staff in its final report, discharge them from further responsibility in this regard at this time, and express to the 34 Task Force members and to the technical staff, its appreciation, in behalf of the entire Cambridge citizenry, for the time and effort they contributed to the City, with the realization that their input will be, and should be, recognized by the City Manager in his recommendation to this City Council.
