WHEREAS:-

The registered voters of the City of Cambridge on November 2, 1971 approved the provisions of Chapter 486 of the Acts of 1971 which authorized fraternal, religious, veterans' and non-profit volunteer fire and ambulance organizations to conduct the game of Beano in the City of Cambridge, which licenses to conduct the game of Beano are issued by the Commissioner of Public Safety after the applications are approved by a majority of the City Council and the City Manager, and

WHEREAS:-

The City of Cambridge has received numerous applications from organizations who are authorized to conduct Beano under the provisions of Chapter 486 of the Acts of 1971, and these applicants are presently awaiting the decision of this City Government in this matter, therefore be it

ORDERED:-

That this City Council hereby designate the License Commission of the City of Cambridge to act as the Licensing Conduit for the City Council to process licenses to conduct Beano Games in accordance with the provisions of said Chapter 486 of the Acts of 1971 and to sign approval in behalf of the City Council before transmitting to the Commissioner of Public Safety, and be it further

ORDERED:-

That the City Manager be and hereby is ordered to take the necessary administrative action to carry out the provisions of this order.
