Purity Supreme Door Closing

Pursuant to your request of October 31, 1985 regarding the above referenced subject, I herewith provide the following information.

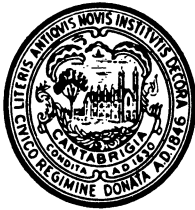
In an effort to confirm the rumor that the Purity Supreme store in Central Square is planning to discontinue its rear door in favor of a new bakery, I contacted Ms. Pat Muldonian, Manager of the store. She informed me that, at present, they have no definite plans for closing the Green Street door which provides access for residents of the Manning Apartments. She did explain, however, that they were in the process of attempting to upgrade the facility which could include the addition of a bakery. Since their plans do not include any structural additions, they would have to work within their existing space limitations which might mean a reorganization of the interior. She emphasized that these plans are in the early stages and no decisions had, as of yet, been made.

Further, she agreed to keep both the City and Central Square Committee informed of their progress and to talk with us about any alternate arrangements that could be made should they actually decide to close the Green Street door.

As such, I will keep your office informed when we learn of any change in the present status.
