WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened at learning of the death of Mr. (Fred) Rogers on February 27, 2003; and

WHEREAS: Fred Rogers was born in Latrobe, PA on March 20, 1928; and

WHEREAS: Fred Rogers introduced "The Children's Corner" in Pittsburgh in 1954; and

WHEREAS: In 1968, the Public Broadcasting Service began to distribute his show, which was ultimately called "Mister Rogers Neighborhood"; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Rogers' show won four Emmy Awards, plus one for Lifetime Achievement and was presented with the George Foster Peabody Award in 1993; and

WHEREAS: Fred never considered himself a TV Star, he was quoted in 1995 as saying "I always thought I was a neighbor who just came in for a visit: and

WHEREAS: The final episode of Mister Rogers Neighborhood aired in August of 2001; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Rogers's passing will leave a void in the lives of all his surviving family, his wife, Joanne, his two sons and two grandsons; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Rogers will be sorely missed by all he touched and loved; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the family of Fred Rogers at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
