That the City Manager be and hereby is requested, to inform the City Council of how the License Commission intends to tighten and monitor its regulations so as to ensure that all codes and regulations are fully complied with at all times; and be it further

ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to inform the License Commission that the City Council desires that the License Commission discontinue its practice of issuing routine relicensing to lodging houses that continue to violate the law.
