- RESOLVED: That I, Alfred E. Vellucci, do establish April 23, 1988 as Hazardous Waste Disposal Day; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That all citizens of Cambridge are invited and urged to bring their hazardous waste materials to the Green Street parking lot behind the Central Square Post Office on Saturday, April 23, 1988 from 9:00 a.m. through 1:00 p.m.
