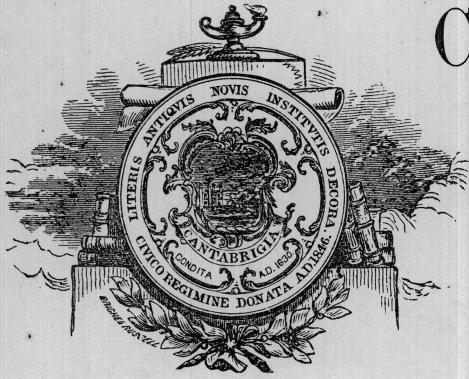




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD 'OF ALDERMEN,

May 21. 1873.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Mendell Street

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *Fifty feet*
in width between

North Avenue And Oxford Street

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

Barbour And Hodges, dated March 21. 1873

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid,

*And that thirty days be allowed for the
removal of fences or other obstructions standing
on the land so taken.*

Adopted. Sent - closed for commencement.
