That the Common Council Chamber be reconstructed as a public hall to be known as Frederick H. Rindge Hall, to be used by citizens who may desire from time to time to hold meetings of a public nature and, it is further

ORDERED:

That His Honor the Mayor be requested to appropriate a sum sufficient to renovate the said Common Council Chamber for the purpose stated in this order.
