- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of the Cambridge City Council that Raymond W. Kelly, Assistant Chief of the New York Police Department, has been appointed First Deputy Commissioner of the department by Police Commissioner Lee P. Brown; and
- WHEREAS: Commissioner Kelly will serve as the Chief Assistant to the Commissioner and will have overall responsibility for the supervision of the department and its operational budget of \$1.6 billion; and
- WHEREAS: Commissioner Kelly was first appointed to the department on June 26, 1963 being promoted to Sergeant in 1969, Lieutenant in 1974, Captain in 1980, Deputy Inspector in 1984, Inspector in 1985 and Assistant Chief on August 15, 1988; attaining an extensive criminal justice background while holding a variety of assignments including, but not limited to, Special Operations, Legal Division, Emergency Service Unit as well as commanding the 71st, 88th and 106th Precincts; and
- WHEREAS: He is the recipient of fifteen department citations as well as receiving a scholarship to the John F. Kennedy School of Government, Harvard University in 1984 earning a Masters Degree in Public Administration; while holding a Master of Law Degree from New York University Law School, a Doctorate of Jurisprudence Degree from St. John's University School of Law and a Bachelor's Degree from Manhattan College; and
- WHEREAS: Commissioner Kelly has served the United States Marine Corps from 1963 to 1966 and currently holds the rank of Colonel in the Marine Corps Reserve; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council go on record extending its sincere congratulations to veteran Police Officer, First Deputy Commissioner Raymond W. Kelly on the occasion of his promotion and to further wish him and his wife, Veronica, good luck and God speed in the years ahead; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation to Raymond W. Kelly on behalf of the entire City Council.
