- WHEREAS: Cambridge already suffers from overly congested streets burdened with parked cars and trucks lined up throughout the various neighborhoods, therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to contact the appropriate individual at the Badger Company to determine whether or not a parking space reduction plan is in fact about to be implemented and further to take the appropriate steps to ensure that should this plan go into effect no adverse impact on the East Cambridge/Kendall Square area will take place.
