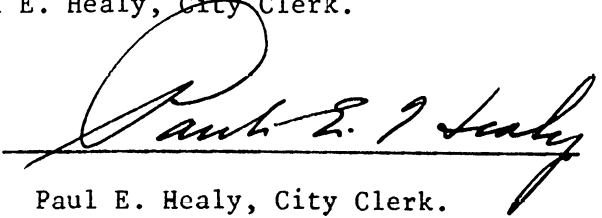
MAYOR RUSSELL
