Watering and Refurbishing City Parks

The Public Works Department for the past three years has been conducting major renovations to the ballfields and parks throughout the City, particularly, in the watering of grass.

As of this date, the following parks have underground sprinklers, tested and in working order:

Donnelly Field Lindstrom Field Comeau Park Raymond St. Park
St. Peters Field Ahern Park Tobin Field

Hoyt Field is under repair and will be working very shortly

Gore St. Park has no underground sprinkler and we have installed a lawn hydrant to attach a portable watering unit

Sennott Park has no facilities at all. We are studying this one to see what can be done

We are also investigating numerous portable units to water areas that do not have underground sprinklers. As soon as we have completed an evaluation, one unit will be purchased.

Additional personnel have been assigned to the park maintenance (with assistance from CETA) to continue the upgrading of our ballfields and parks this summer.

I hope everyone realizes that as an urban City, with limited open spaces, our ballfields and parks are subjected to extensive use.

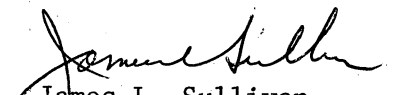
