③ That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the appropriate department repair the deep depression in the brick sidewalk near the fire hydrant at 42 Irving Street. This hole is a health and safety hazard.

④ That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the DPW to advertise the sidewalk snow removal hotline in the TAB and the Chronicle and on cable television.

⑤ That the Boston Globe be requested to enclose its newspapers delivered at home in bags that are completely recyclable (the #4 bags the Globe uses, even though labelled as "recyclable," are only accepted if people deposit them at the DPW yard).

⑥ Whereas the extensive curb cuts possessed by the Gulf Station at the corner of Garfield Street and Massachusetts Avenue mean that pedestrians rarely have much protection from motor vehicles entering the station lot from multiple angles and directions;

Resolved that the City Manager be and hereby is requested to ask the appropriate staff to discuss the possibility of narrowing these curb cuts with the owner of the property with the view in mind of making this intersection more pedestrian friendly.
