WHEREAS: Many requests have been made to have the gate adjacent to the Manning Apartments in the Green Street Parking garage fixed so that the senior citizens and disabled people who live in the apartments can exit the garage without having to walk a half block to bring their groceries and other belongings in and out from their cars; and

WHEREAS: This proposal has usually generated a negative response from the Department of Traffic and Parking because of security reasons; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Police Commissioner and the Director of Traffic and Parking to confer with one another concerning the feasibility of devising some system so that the elderly and disabled people of the Manning Apartments will have entrance and exit privileges to that garage safely and report back to the City Council at our next scheduled meeting.

Adopted by the affirmative vote of nine members.

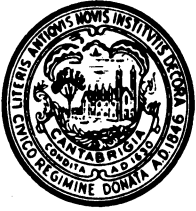
