In response to Awaiting Report Item Number 03-123, regarding a report improving lighting in and around the Manning Apartments, with special attention to the common area, city garage and street lighting in the area, City Electrician George Fernandes reports the following:

All exterior lighting around the Manning Apartments, Central Square Library, and Green Street Parking Facility including street lighting was inspected and reviewed by the Electrical Department. It was determined that the lighting in this area is adequate, with the exception of the courtyard behind the library.

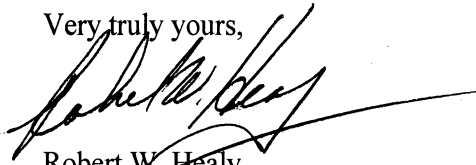
In the parking garage, all the lights that were found to be not operating properly have been repaired. This includes two outside lights on the Franklin Street side of the garage, and lights that were out on the parking area of the roof.

Lighting owned by Cambridge Housing Authority around Manning Apartments are fully operational and adequate.

There were two streetlights on Franklin Street that have been repaired By NStar Electric.

Lighting for the rear entrance of the library and rear courtyard were not operating properly and are inadequate. An order has been placed for new fixtures at this location and installation is expected by December 12th.
