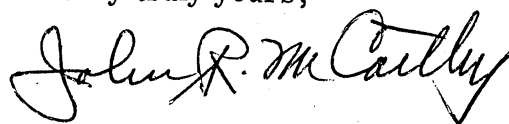

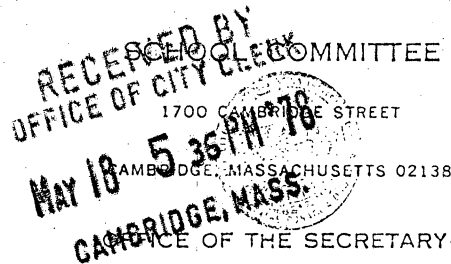

ORDERED:

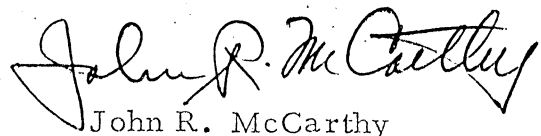

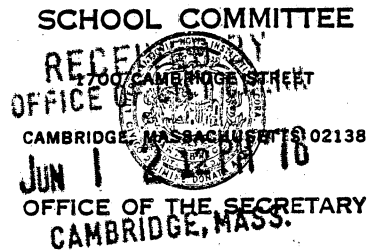

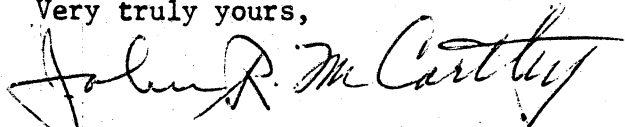
