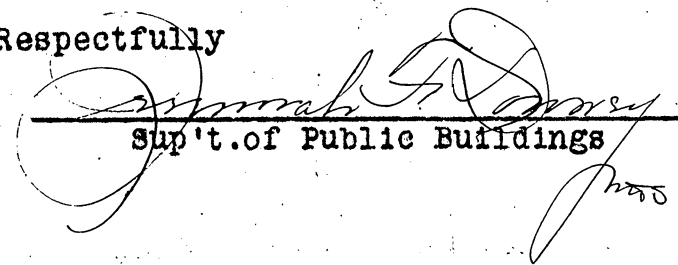

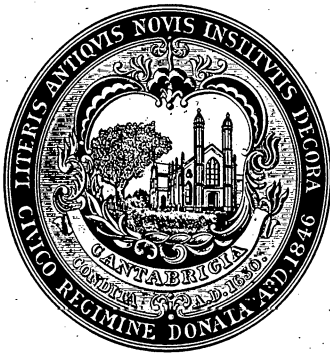
Dear Sir:-

In the matter of the installation of a passenger elevator at the Brattle Square City Building for Post 56, G.A.R. I find that a communication from Your Honor upon this subject was sent to the City Council and referred to the Committee on Public Property.

Anticipating action by the City Council upon the matter, I investigated the necessary requirements and would report that the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.) is necessary to install and make the necessary changes in the building for a direct connected electric passenger elevator.
