WHEREAS: Abt Associates is a Cambridge firm which employs 500 people and cares for 50 children at their Day Care Center on Wheeler Street; and

WHEREAS: The intersection of Wheeler Street and Concord Avenue is extremely hazardous during the late afternoon rush hours; therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to instruct the Chief of Police to assign a traffic officer to this intersection between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Mondays through Friday; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to consult with the appropriate officials of the Metropolitan District Commission with a view towards providing for the construction of a catwalk over Concord Avenue to the Shopping Center.
