Gentlemen-

In reply to an order dated January 9th, 1923, that this Board clean the ice on Rindge Field for the purpose of skating, etc., I would say that the Board of Park Commissioners today have made a request that His Honor, take up the matter of providing an appropriation of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS to enable the department to clear the snow from all areas on the playgrounds under the department.

An item was included in the budget of last year calling for clearing ice at all playgrounds but as this was not granted no work can be attempted, unless the additional appropriation is made.
