Whereas: In the opinion of this Board, the interests of the public require that the location of the Cambridge Railroad Company on Dover Street, between North Avenue and the Somerville line, should be revoked, and due notice thereof, and hearing thereon having been given according to law, it is

Ordered: That the location heretofore granted by the Board of Aldermen to the Cambridge Railroad Company, of its tracks on Dover Street, as aforesaid, be and hereby is revoked. and that said Company be required to remove said tracks, in conformity with this Order, after thirty days from date, and to put said street in as good condition as it was in, immediately before being occupied by said tracks.

The foregoing being in accordance with

the provisions of Section 22 of Chapter
113 of the Public Statutes.
