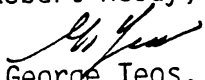

Subject City Council Order #7 dated 5/18/92 Re: Pedestrian Light on Belmont St.

The Traffic Department will conduct a study of the use of the pedestrian actuated signal on Belmont St. at the Sacred Heart School. At the same time, we will conduct a traffic signal study at the intersection of Cushing St. and Belmont Street.

The reason we cannot move the existing control equipment from the school to the intersection is that in order to install a traffic light at Cushing St. and Belmont St., we would have to signalize both Cushing St. and Belmont St. with an exclusive pedestrian phase as required by State Law. The only equipment we could use from the school signal is the mast arm and signals. We would also have to install underground conduit, cable and detectors.

As soon as the results of the study is completed, we will forward it to you with our recommendations.

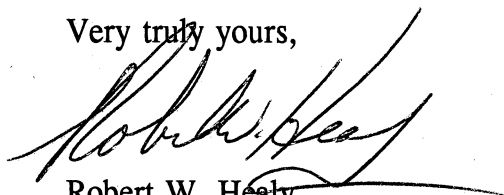
