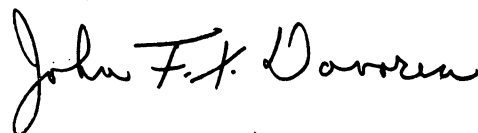

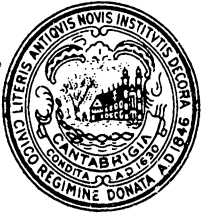

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

To conduct research, scientific inquiry, and studies of the validity, usefulness, and process of astrological inquiry, thought, and research; the corporation shall undertake the design, fund-raising, and management of research studies; conduct meetings of interested people; engage in the design and conduct of seminars and other educational experiences; and publish the results of research and the description of educational programs offered. The corporation shall from time to time engage in the activities of research, fund-raising, education, publishing, and consulting insofar as these lead to further scientific understanding of astrological research and process. The corporation shall further engage in any activities, events, or relationships which shall further the interests and purposes of the corporation as permitted by the General Laws of the Commonwealth.

This corporation shall not engage in any activities for profit.

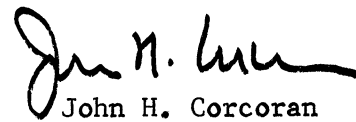
