- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Peter Salvi, late retired owner and operator of Salvi Motors; and
- WHEREAS: Peter immigrated to Boston at the age of eighteen and later operated his own construction firm in Somerville prior to founding the Main Street Garage in 1929, selling Chryslers, and in 1935, along with changing the name of the dealership to Salvi Motors, changed the product to Oldsmobiles; and
- WHEREAS: Peter left the automotive business in 1961 but continued working as a prominent realtor in Somerville, where he was an active participant in civic and fraternal organizations, serving as a charter member of the Somerville Lodge of Elks and as a life member of the Ancient and Honorable Artillery Company; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Ada Salvi of Belmont and to the entire Salvi family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Salvi on behalf of the entire City Council.
