Ordered,

That the Mayor be authorized and requested, in the name and on behalf of the City, to petition the Harbor Commissioners, for permission to place a float on the western side of Canal or Craigie's Bridge as a pier on the Boston end of said Bridge and also for the removal of the Boat House of the West-End Boat Club, at the Cambridge end of said Bridge, so as to allow the Steam Ferry Boat of the City to run between floats at either end of said Bridge for the conveyance of passengers.
