Dear Mr. Sullivan:

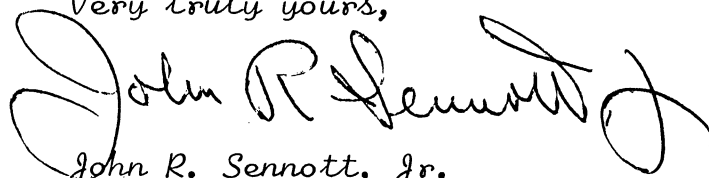
I submit herewith my notice of retirement effective November 1, 1976, as chairman and member of the Cambridge License Commission and of the Pole and Conduit Commission.

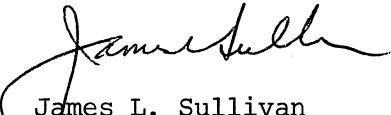
