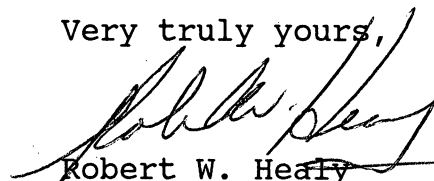
To the Honorable, the City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report #41 regarding storm drains on Standish Street, please be advised of the following:

Elizabeth Epstein, director of the Conservation Commission, has discussed the flooding problems on Standish Street with some of the affected residents. Although a drainage channel exists behind the houses on the even-numbered side of the street, this does not appear to be within the Commission's jurisdiction.

The Sewer Division of the Department of Public Works has inspected and cleaned the catch basin and storm drainage pipes. On the larger issue of drainage in the area, a major reconstruction and re-alignment of the storm drainage system is needed.
