- WHEREAS: The Teevan Traffic Circle was dedicated on Veterans Day November 11, 1951; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council congratulates Steve Buckley on his efforts to keep the memory of Cambridge Veteran **Albert S. Teevan, Jr.** alive and to be long remembered and never forgotten.
