#### ORDER OF NOTICE

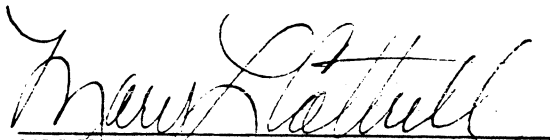
Petition of Boston Edison Company for authority to construct, maintain and operate certain underground transmission lines under the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 164, Section 72 and for a determination that locations upon, under, along or across certain boulevards or reservations in the care and control of the Metropolitan District Commission will be and are required by public convenience and necessity for wires, cables or pipes for the transmission of electricity under the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 92, Section 43.

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Upon the foregoing petition, the Department of Public Utilities will conduct a public hearing at its hearing room, #1210 Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts on Friday, February 13, 1987 at 10:00 a.m.

The Petitioner, Boston Edison Company, is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof, once at least fourteen (14) days prior to said date in the Boston Globe and the Boston Herald; to serve a copy hereof by registered mail at least fourteen (14) days prior to said date on the Mayors and City Clerks of the cities of Cambridge, Everett, Boston and Somerville, and on all persons owning real estate affected by this petition, and to make return of service and publication at the time of hearing.
