IN CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS: Implementing the regulations of the Community Development Block Grant Program (Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974) requires annual adoption by the City Council of a resolution of accomplish the following:

1. Direct that a Block Grant application be filed for funding;
2. Direct the City Manager or Assistant City Manager for Community Development acting for the City Manager, to file said application, make amendments as required and execute related contracts; and
3. Direct that the Federal Government be notified that Cambridge will comply with all Block Grant Program assurances and understandings required by law and administrative regulations; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the fulfillment of the requirements of the foregoing paragraph be the City Manager or the Assistant City Manager for Community Development is authorized hereby and, in addition, specifically that the City Manager or Assistant City Manager for Community Development file an application for Federal Block Grant entitlement funds available to Cambridge in Fiscal Year 1994 as provided by the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended; and be it further

ORDERED: That said application be filed with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development on or before May 31, 1993, for the required thirty (30) day review.

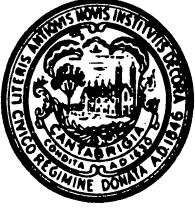

To The Honorable, The City Council:

The attached resolution authorizes and directs the City Manager to apply for and administer the Fiscal Year 1994 CDBG funds available to Cambridge under the U.S. Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 as amended.

The language of the resolution is the same as enacted by the City Council annually for the past seventeen years. The resolution is required as part of the CDBG application, which must be filed Monday, May 31st.

Through its passage of the City's Fiscal Year 1994 budget on May 24, 1993, the City Council concurrently approved the City Manager's CDBG budget as it appears in the application to be submitted May 31st. This is because our CDBG funds are allocated and spent as part of the City budget.
