WHEREAS:-

Present transportation lines to the Soldier's Home in Chelsea do not include the distance between established bus stops and the Hospital on Powder Hill, and

WHEREAS:-

The walk up hill is difficult and in the case of those visiting there or entering for treatment, it is virtually impossible because of their age or physical conditions, and

WHEREAS:-

The matter has been called to the attention of the Metropolitan Transit Authority and has been sent to the Governor in the form of a request for his help

RESOLVED:-

That the Cambridge City Council records itself in favor of the communication sent by La Societe des 40 Hommes at 8 Chevaux to Governor Paul A. Dever, State House, Boston, Massachusetts, requesting the Metropolitan Transit Authority to make the necessary arrangements to run a Bus Line to the Soldier's Home, Powder Hill, Chelsea, for the convenience of the hundreds of disabled veterans and citizens who go there each day either to visit at the Hospital or to go there for treatment, and it is further

RESOLVED:-

That a copy of these resolutions be forwarded by the City Clerk to his Excellency, Paul A. Dever, Governor of Massachusetts.
