An Ordinance

in addition to the Ordinance in relation to the Fire Department.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:-

Sec. 1. The Ordinance in relation to the Fire Department is amended in section first, second line, by inserting after the word "Engineers" the word, "Hosemen"; in section third, first-line by expunging the word "other" and inserting the word "Assistant"; and in the third line of the same section, by inserting after the word "cars", the word "Assistant"; in section fourth, tenth line, by inserting after the word "Engines" the word "Hoses"; in section ninth, first-line, by inserting after the word "each" the word "band"; in section twenty-ninth by striking out the words "semi-annually to each member" of the and inserting the words "monthly to the Engines and Drivers of Steam Fire Engines and semi-annually to other members";

nothing is seen over.

Sec. 2 - Said Ordinance is further amended, by adding the following sections:-
Section Thirty Nine. Each steam Fire Engine company appointed by the Mayor and Aldermen shall consist of fourteen men, and shall have a Foreman, Assistant Foreman, Engineer, Fireman, Driver and nine Hosemen. The

Foreman and Assistant Foreman shall be chosen by ballot, subject to the approval of the board of Engineers, and of the Mayor and Aldermen; and any person rejected shall not be returned the second time for approval. The Engineer and Driver shall be ~~permanently~~ ^{constantly} employed, and shall at all times be in or about the Engine House, except when unavoidably absent.

Section 40. The Foreman of each Steam Engine company shall at fire's direct, the locating of the engine, and have charge and direction of the hoseman.

Section 41. The Assistant Foreman of each Steam Engine Company shall assist the foreman in the discharge of his duties, and also act as Clerk of said company.

Section 42. The Engineer of each Steam Engine company shall, under the direction of the Board of Engineers have the sole care of the engine-house, and all the property therein belonging to the City. He shall be held personally responsible for the care and condition of the Engine, shall work the same, and ~~see that~~ ^{have} it ~~is~~ at all times ready for immediate use. He shall be accountable for the proper performance of all duties required of the Driver and Firemen, and make report to the Chief Engineer of any neglect on their part.

Section 43. The Driver of each Steam Engine company shall drive, and have charge of the horses, ~~see that the same are~~ ^{and have} ~~at all~~

times ready for immediate use, and the stable kept neat and clean. He shall also assist the Engineer in keeping the horse and apparatus clean, and both Engineer and Driver shall perform such other duties as may be required of them by the Chief Engineer.
