To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the transfer of \$31,000 from the Library Salary & Wages Account to the Library Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to provide funds for the following projects:

- Install a CD ROM tower to enable the central mounting of CD ROM reference resource data bases. The data bases will be accessible to patrons of the branch libraries as well as the reference department of the main library.
- Purchase a new laser bar code reader for all circulation locations. New technology requires the replacement of the present terminals with personal computers at these locations and the current bar code readers are not compatible with the new personal computers.
- Installation of new exterior signs at the Collins, O'Connell, and Valente Branches and the Main Library similar to those already installed at the Central Square and North Cambridge Branches. This will complete a system of uniform, attractive signage and improve library building identification by the public.
- Paint the exterior of the Collins Branch, which will be the last phase of renovations to this branch.
