

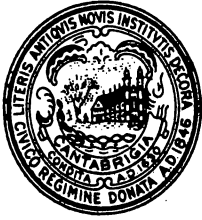

To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am pleased to announce to the City Council that the Commissioner of Health and Hospitals has received a grant, in the amount of \$9,000.00, from the Massachusetts Department of Public Health to carry out a nurses' training program in hypertension management. This program will train eleven (11) nurses in hypertension management and patient education. These nurses have been chosen from a cross-section of the City's health care delivery system, including six (6) neighborhood health centers, the hospital-based primary care unit, and a private practitioner's office. Although the grant proceeds will total \$9,000.00, \$445.00 has been set aside for staff support and \$8,555.00 will be appropriated for the direct program costs.

Passage of the attached orders is recommended.
