In Board of Aldermen, *May 12, 1885.*

Ordered,

500.- That whenever John C. Cassidy, shall pay to the City Treasurer the sum of Five Hundred Dollars, then he shall be released from his contract with the city in the matter of a Gravel Bank at Watertown, said contract being dated Dec. 29, 1879, - and the Mayor shall be authorized in the name and on behalf of the city, ^{to} execute a deed of release to said Cassidy of all right and title, which the City of Cambridge may hold in certain lands in said Watertown, as conveyed to the city by deed dated Dec 29, 1879, and recorded in Middlesex South Registry Deeds, Lib. 1555 Fol. 552.

Provided: That any time prior to Dec 1, 1885, the City shall have a right to enter upon the lands described in the deed aforesaid, and remove such screened gravel and Field Stones as may be upon said land and belonging to this city.
